Sub:- Grant of Conditional Permission to the State Unani Medical College & Hakim Ahmed Hussain Republic Day Memorial Hospital, Himmatganj, Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh (Inst Id.) with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BUMS) course and 02 PG courses with 10 seats (12 seats including EWS) namely (i) Ain uzn Anf Wa Halaq wa Asnan- 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) and (ii) Ilaj bit Tadbeer-05 seats (06 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2022-23 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-regarding

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under.

Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **State Unani Medical College & Hakim Ahmed Hussain Republic Day Memorial Hospital, Himmatganj, Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh** inspection of your College was conducted on **03.11.2022 & 04.11.2022** and revisited on **16.11.2022 & 17.11.2022** by hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BUMS) course and 02 PG courses with 10 seats (12 seats including EWS) namely (i) Ain uzn Anf Wa Halaq wa Asnan- 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) and (ii) Ilaj bit Tadbeer-05 seats (06 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2022-23 under Section 28 of NCISM Act 2020.
2. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Unani Education) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under, and on the basis of Relaxation policy issued by the NCISM dated 16.03.2022.
3. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in **24th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **16.12.2022** and the board decided to provide an opportunity to the college to submit an undertaking/affidavit issued by the appointing authority for fulfillment of the shortcomings. On the basis of the assessment report and undertaking submitted by Additional Chief Secretary, Department of AYUSH, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh vide ref. No. IN-UP84652145626034U dated 20.12.2022, it has been decided by the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine to grant **Conditional Permission to the State Unani Medical College & Hakim Ahmed Hussain Republic Day Memorial Hospital, Himmatganj, Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BUMS) course and 02 PG courses with 10 seats (12 seats including EWS) namely (i) Ain uzn Anf Wa Halaq wa Asnan- 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) and (ii) Ilaj bit Tadbeer-05 seats (06 seats including EWS) the academic session 2022-23 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020** subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following requirements:-

1. It is informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats and Postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) and 02 PG courses with 10 seats (12 seats including EWS) shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2022-23 and counseling for the remaining 85% of UG & PG seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the said Counseling authority to admit students as per their rules/reservation policies/norms. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota of the students admitted thereunder.
4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
6. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2022 and compliance report should be sent to get permission for the session 2023-24:
 - i. all the requirements of Minimum Standard of Infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - ii. all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Unani);
 - iii. all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Unani Education) regulations, 2015; and
 - iv. all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
7. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission from the academic session 2023-24.
