Subject: Grant of Yearly Permission to State Unani Medical College, & Hakim Ahmed Husain Republic Day Memorial Hospital, Old GT Rd, near SBI ATM, Khuldabad, Himatganj, Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh :11001 (Inst. ID UN10304) with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (B JMS) course and 25 seats (27 seats including EWS)[instead of 35 seats (37 seats including EWS)] in 07 PG courses namely, (i) Ain Uzn Anaf Wa Halaq- 05 seats (06 seats including EWS), (ii) Ilaj Bit Tadabeer-05 seats (06 seats including EWS), (iii) Kulliyat-Umoor-e-Tabiya- 05 seats, (iv) Munafe-ul-Aza- 02 seats (instead of 05 seats), (v) Ilmul Amraz - 04 seats (instead of 05 seats), (vi) Amraz E Jild Wa Tazeeniyat - 03 seats (instead of 05 seats) and (vii) Ilmul Atfal- 01 seats (instead of 05 seats) for the academic year 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

1. This is with reference to an appeal ref. No. 846/SUMC/2025-26 dated 26.07.2025 enclosing an undertaking cum affidavit vide ref. no. IN-UP89153877275578X dated 13.08.2025 submitted by Mr. Manvendra Singh, IAS, DG, Ayush department, Lucknow to the Commission against the order passed by the President, MARBISM vide letter of even no. dated 23.07.2025 with regards to issuance of permission with seat Reduction in UG (B JMS) Course for the Academic year 2025-26.
2. In view of the above, the Chairman, NCISM decided to consider the submission made by Mr. Manvendra Singh, IAS, DG, Ayush department, Lucknow, against the impugned order dated 23.07.2025 passed by the MARB-ISM.
3. Further, a letter vide Ref. no. 51-03/2025-26/Comm. Appeal/College(Unani) dated 18.08.2025 has been received from the Secretary, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM to grant permission to State Unani Medical College, & Hakim Ahmed Husain Republic Day Memorial Hospital, Old GT Rd, near SBI ATM, Khuldabad, Himatganj, Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh 211001 (Inst. ID UN10304) for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 as per concerned act and regulations.

"DECISION"

4. Therefore, in view of above, State Unani Medical College, & Hakim Ahmed Husain Republic Day Memorial Hospital, Old GT Rd, near SBI ATM, Khuldabad, Himatganj, Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh 211001 (Inst. ID UN10304) is hereby granted with :-
 - a) Yearly Permission in UG (BUMS) course with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) for the academic session 2025-26 in accordance with Regulation 16 (2) & 16 (3)(h) of MESAR UG (Unani) 2023.
 - b) Yearly permission with 25 seats (27 seats including EWS)[instead of 35 seats (37 seats including EWS)] in 07 PG courses namely, (i) Ain Uzn Anaf Wa Halaq- 05 seats (06 seats including EWS), (ii) Ilaj Bit Tadabeer-05 seats (06 seats including EWS), (iii) Kulliyat-Umoor-e-Tabiya- 05 seats, (iv) Munafe-ul-Aza- 02 seats (instead of 05 seats), (v) Ilmul Amraz - 04 seats (instead of 05 seats), (vi) Amraz E Jild Wa Tazeeniyat - 03 seats (instead of 05 seats) and (vii) Ilmul Atfal- 01 seats (instead of 05 seats) as per the approved seat reduction policy.
5. The aforementioned decision is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-
 1. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 25 seats (27 seats including EWS)[instead of 35 seats (37 seats including EWS)] in 07 PG courses

shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

- 1) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 2) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 3) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 4) **The aforementioned shortcomings and following requirements should be fulfilled by the college and the compliance report shall be submitted before 31st December, 2025 in order to be considered for the process of issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder, should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Unani colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2023.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education) Regulations-2022.
 - iv) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Unani) Regulations, 2024.
- 5) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
